One of the points that we must not miss is the connection between the mouth and the heart. As painful as it is to acknowledge, what often comes out of our mouths is a strong indication of the condition of our hearts. When we profess faith and love in God, our actions must be consistent with our profession of faith. the things that we speak are an indicator of the condition of our hearts.

In the Gospels, Jesus uses the metaphor or analogy of a Tree and its Fruit to get His disciples to more deeply consider the power of the tongue to reveal the truth of one's heart:

⁴³ "No good tree bears bad fruit, nor again does a bad tree bear good fruit; ⁴⁴ for each tree is known by its own fruit. Figs are not gathered from thorns, nor are grapes picked from a bramble bush. ⁴⁵ The good person out of the good treasure of the heart produces good, and the evil person out of evil treasure produces evil; for it is out of the abundance of the heart that the mouth speaks. Luke 6:43-45 NRSV

³³ "Either make the tree good, and its fruit good; or make the tree bad, and its fruit bad; for the tree is known by its fruit. ³⁴ You brood of vipers! How can you speak good things, when you are evil? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. ³⁵ The good person brings good things out of a good treasure, and the evil person brings evil things out of an evil treasure. ³⁶ I tell you, on the day of judgment you will have to give an account for every careless word you utter; ³⁷ for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned." Matthew 12:33-37

READ JAMES 3:13-18 WISDOM AND KNOWLEDGE

James says that our works of faith should be done with gentleness and "born of wisdom" (vs 13b).

Wisdom has to do with the application of knowledge and the quality of our decisions. Are they sound? Are they Right? Are they Fair?

Wisdom is the ability to discern and judge right responses, words, or actions related to knowledge.

Knowledge relates to facts, ideas, and information gained through observation, research, study, or experience.

Living a life of obedience to God's Word requires not only a knowledge of Scripture but the Wisdom of God to speak truth with love and to make right decisions.

If words of truth are proceeding from a wounded or tainted heart, those words will only hurt and not heal.

WHAT IS ENVY? a feeling of discontented or resentful longing aroused by someone else's possessions, qualities, or luck.
